

## **Ford City Code of Conduct**

Ford City is committed to providing a family friendly and pleasant shopping experience for everyone. We ask all of our guests to conduct themselves in a respectful way in accordance with the code of conduct and all laws and local ordinances.

Smoking or Vaping inside the mall or within 20 feet of any entrance is prohibited.

No alcoholic beverages, controlled substances or gambling allowed anywhere on Property.

No videotaping or photography anywhere on the premises without prior management approval.

No skateboarding, roller-blading, or free running anywhere on the premises. Behaving in a disorderly or noisy manner is not permitted.

No solicitation, demonstrations, surveys, posting of hand bills, or distribution of literature without management prior approval.

No loitering or congregating that blocks walkways, storefronts or impedes the flow of pedestrian or vehicle traffic

Musical instruments, radios, and other devices are to be kept at a volume that does not disturb others.

Shirts and shoes are to be worn at all times. Attire that may be deemed as obscene, offensive or likely to provoke a disturbance is prohibited.

Inappropriate attire includes but not limited to sagging pants, caps tilted either left or right, wearing hoods (jackets or sweatshirts) or masks.

Bicycles are not to be ridden on sidewalks and may only be secured to bike racks provided for this purpose. The use of signs, trees, or other structures is not permitted. Bicycles left on racks after mall hours are subject to removal.

Motor vehicles are to abide by posted road signs at all times; vehicles parked illegally or in loading docks may be subject to towing at the owner of the vehicles expense.

No parking in fire lanes, along curbs, in crosswalks, or double parking. Vehicles found in violation are subject to towing at vehicles owners expense.

Cars must be parked inside clearly marked parking spaces.

Trash and recyclables are to be disposed of in designated receptacles only.

No Pets allowed on premises, service animals permitted.

No Playing, wading, or throwing of foreign objects in the fountains.

No weapons of any kind are permitted on premises.

On School days children six (6) to sixteen (16) years of age are not allowed on Ford City property without a parent or legal guardian or without a valid work permit before during regular school hours.

Ford City is private property and security has the authority to enforce the code of conduct and to ask anyone not in compliance to leave the property immediately. Failure or refusal to leave will result in a ban from the property and/or arrest and prosecution for criminal trespass.

Ford City expressly retains the right to revise or modify this code of conduct as necessary and without notice.

## **Youth Escort Policy**

Anyone under 18 years of age visiting Ford City must be accompanied by a parent or supervising adult, age 21 or older, Fridays and Saturdays after 6pm.

One parent or adult escort can supervise up to 4 youths. All accompanied youth must remain with the supervising adult at all times. The supervising adult is responsible for all the youths they accompany.

Visitors are responsible for carrying acceptable proof of age. Acceptable ID must include photo with date of birth such as driver's license, military or college ID or passport. Those without proper ID will be denied entry or asked to leave the property.
